1	When you arrive	
	You need a valid Reader's Ticket with you to gain access to the Reading Room.	
_	You must sign the Attendance Book in the Entrance Hall on the Ground Floor each day.	
2	Going into the Reading Room	
	In the Reading Room, you may bring only material for taking notes (pencils), notebooks,	
	personal computers (without case), electronic devices and digital devices (without cases).	
	Everything else must be left in the lockers on the Ground Floor.	
3	When in the Reading Room	
	You should observe silence except when consulting a member of staff.	
	Please treat fellow Readers with courtesy and respect.	
4	When consulting Archives	
	Archives are fragile and you must treat them with respect:	
	 You must only use pencils for taking notes, 	
	 You must not remove archives or microforms from the Reading Room, 	
	 You must not bring any items liable to cause damage to archives into the Reading Room, 	
	 You must not try to re-arrange files or bundles of documents, 	
	 You must not disbind files for the purposes of photography or copying, 	
	 You must not lean on, or mark, documents. 	
5	When using our catalogues and finding aids	
	 Do not write on them or mark them. 	
	 Use the cushions provided to support the spines. 	
	 Replace them on the shelves when you are finished. 	
6	Taking digital images	
	You may only take digital images with permission. You must sign a permission form in	
	advance. This must be done daily.	
	You may use digital devices to take images. Phones are allowed in airplane mode only.	
7	Please discuss your requirements with the Duty Archivist. Confidential Page 2014.	
7	<u>Confidential Records</u>	
	You may need to sign a Data Protection Form if you are looking at personal information.	
	Please contact the Duty Archivist.

	Archives may be subject to copyright. You will need to apply for permission if you want to	
	publish or reproduce any archives.	
	 Fees may apply – please consult the National Archives (Fees) Regulations, 2012
