

## BEFORE YOUR VISIT

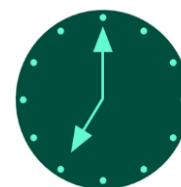
1. **The capacity of the National Archives Reading Room has been reduced** to comply with health and safety requirements and all intending visitors must make an appointment online:

- 3 It is recommended that you **bring and wear a face mask.**



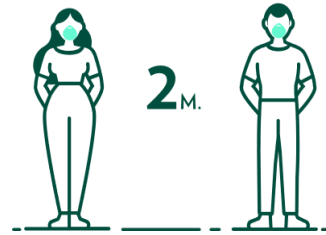
- 4 Payment for copying and other services can be accepted **by card only.**
